

mjf Volunteer Role Descriptions

Front of House

The heart of our volunteer team, welcoming visitors to venues and events throughout mjf. Responsibilities will include: ticket checking, guest welcoming, event monitoring.

Merchandise

Often working as part of the front of house team selling mjf and artist merchandise to visitors. Responsibilities will include: money handling, card machine use, stock checking.

VIP Host

Working with mjf staff to host our partners and sponsors. Responsibilities will include: small-scale event hosting, basic hospitality tasks.

Artist Liaison

First-hand experience with our artists in preparation for their performances at mjf. Responsibilities will include: artist monitoring, green room support.

Runner

A crucial role as we see mjf expand across Manchester City Centre. Applicants should have a good knowledge of central Manchester and willingness to be on their feet. Responsibilities will include: transporting equipment and information between venues.

Welfare

Helping to ensure the day-to-day welfare of our wonderful volunteer team. Responsibilities will include: daily personnel checks, weather monitoring.

Administrative and Office Support

Offering support to the mjf staff during the lead up to the festival. Responsibilities will include: basic office tasks, word processing.

Photography/Videography

Capturing the essence of mjf. Applicants should have a show-reel or portfolio available for mjf staff to view.

Stage Management

Working with our in-house production manager to manage one of our mjf stages. Applicants should have: demonstrable previous experience managing a stage or event (at any level).

Technical Support

Shadowing a member of our in-house technical crew on sound and lighting. Responsibilities will include: aiding in rigging and derigging, mixing and stage set up as appropriate. Applicants should have: demonstrable experience in one of the areas above (at any level).



Backstage Crew

Helping with the general maintenance and working of the festival from set-up to pack-down.

Responsibilities will include: site construction/deconstruction, painting, general maintenance

Applicants should have: experience (or willingness) in heavy lifting, carpentry or other manual skills
